Gwinnett Online Campus (GOC) — the school system's full-time diploma-granting school with grades 4-12 offers a flexible learning environment, extensive support from teachers and counselors, individualized instruction, and a full range of courses.

The virtual high school opened in 2011 for students in grades 9-12, added grades 6-8 in August 2012, and greeted grades 4-5 this fall. GOC students must meet all graduation requirements for credits and assessments.

High school students have access to classes in the core academic areas, modern and classical languages, health and PE, technical education, Advanced Placement, and a variety of electives and connection courses.

Students in grades 4-8 enjoy course offerings which include language arts, math, science, social studies, foreign language, and a variety of connections classes unique to the online environment.

Unlike the traditional setting, GOC students work online at the time of day that works best for their schedule. Face-to-face meetings occur on campus for hands-on labs, interactive learning labs, and testing.

During these campus visits, along with other opportunities such as on and off-campus Rich Experiences, students form study groups and friendships while enhancing 21st century skills.

Supplemental Program/Guided Study at GOC

The **GOC Supplemental Program** offers solutions for GCPS students aspiring to get ahead or make room in their schedule for additional electives. Students can choose from more than 174 online courses to take outside of their regular class schedule. During 2013-14, nearly 5,000 segments were delivered through the GOC Supplemental Program.

Guided Study courses are also available through GOC for students who need to recover credits for a failed class in order to get, and stay, on track for graduation.
